The time and date fixed for the receipt of nominations must be at least 96 hours before the time fixed for the commencement of the annual meeting; and before the time of the first service held on the Sunday immediately preceding the meeting.

Eligibility for Nominations to Church Office (ie Parish Council and Warden)

- Be a **Communicant** Member of the Anglican Church of Australia (Rule 13.1 – Schedule 1, Parish Governance Act 2013, Anglican Diocese of Melbourne). That is, either **Confirmed** or Formally **Received** into the Anglican Church by a Bishop
- Be a layperson (i.e. not ordained).
- Be over eighteen years of age.
- Be baptised.
- Have regularly and habitually attended public worship in that parish.
- Be a member of the Anglican Church of Australia (definition: *"a member of this Church means a baptised person who attends the public worship of this Church and declares that he is a member of this Church and of no Church which is not in communion with this Church"*)
- Not be a member of another church or denomination.
- Not be on the electoral roll of another parish or congregation.
- Have completed and signed an application to be on the electoral roll.
